
Dear Ms. Nguyen:

The Calleguas Creek Watershed Management Plan Steering Committee appreciates the opportunity to provide comments on the revisions to the *Calleguas Creek Watershed Nitrogen Compounds and Related Effects TMDL* (Nitrogen TMDL) wasteload allocations. We appreciate the Regional Board's consideration of the identified typographical errors in the Nitrogen TMDL. We also appreciate the coordination of the Regional Board staff between the permitting and TMDL departments to resolve the issues with the TMDL identified during the permit renewal process.

We are submitting these comments to provide full support of the approval of the revisions to the wasteload allocations in the Nitrogen TMDL.
